Recently, Mission Hill NHS has been working more closely with Northeastern University through our collaboration with Stephen Schneider, Director of Horticulture and Grounds at NU, and his two co-op



students. This partnership is invaluable as we work towards certifying Kevin W. Fitzgerald Park as a Level I Arboretum. Stephen and his co-ops and MHNHS's intern conducted site visits to the Park to inventory all species and are finalizing a Master Plan and MHNHS's Arbor Day event - all requirements for a Level I status. Parcel 25: Phase 2

Having spent over a year to properly remediate the Parcel 25 Phase 2 site after environmental issues were encountered in 2020, the 46-unit, 100% affordable, LIHTC rental project for families is now returning to traditional construction. MHNHS anticipates completion in late spring of 2023. Maloney Properties, our management agent, will likely begin the lottery process for rent-up of the units in early 2023.
